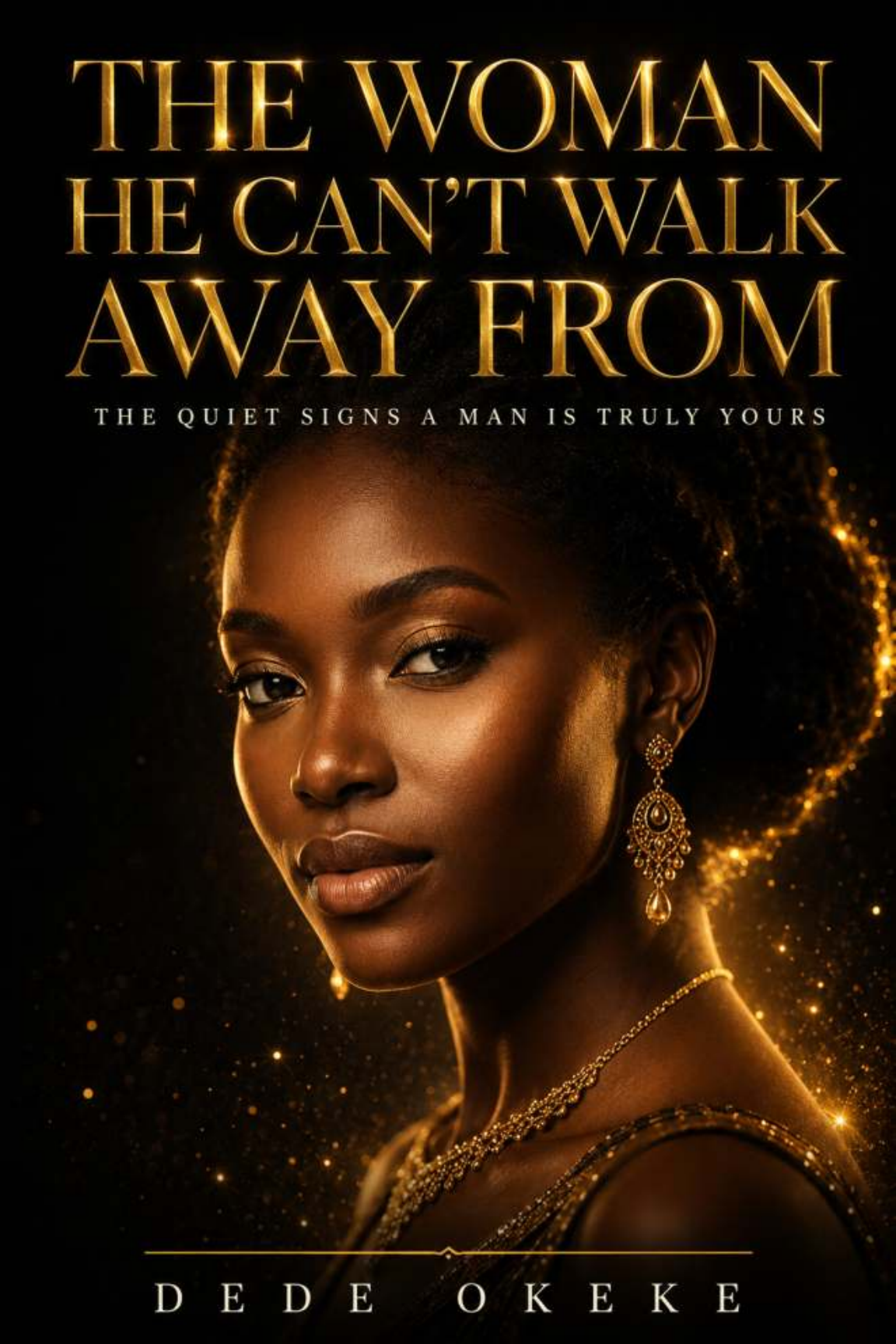

Listen closely to the small words a man uses. They tell you more than he realizes.

A man who is not sure about you will speak carefully. He will say "I" instead of "we." He will talk about his plans without asking where you fit into them. He keeps his future a private room that you are not invited into.

A man who is truly yours does the opposite. Without even noticing, he starts saying "we." He mentions next year and expects you to be there. A man who truly loves you will guard something you may not even notice he is guarding: your peace of mind.

This does not mean he never makes mistakes. It means he tries not to add unnecessary stress to your life. He tells you the truth, even when a lie would be easier for him. He lets you know where he stands instead of leaving you to guess. He does not play games meant to make you jealous or unsure.

Think of the difference between a man who keeps you calm and a man who keeps you anxious. One replies to your messages instead of leaving you wondering for days. One is honest about his intentions instead of keeping you in limbo. One does not flirt with other people just to see your reaction.

Naomi lived this truth in her relationship. Her partner was not perfect, but he was steady. If he was going to be late, he told her early, not after she had already worried for an hour. If something was bothering him, he said so, instead of going cold and silent. She realized, slowly, that her mind had grown quiet around him. She was not checking her phone with a knot in her stomach anymore.

HE STAYS EVEN WHEN THINGS GET HARD

Anyone can stay during the easy months. The real test of love comes during conflict, stress, illness, or hard seasons of life.

A man who is not truly committed often disappears the moment things become difficult. He grows distant during arguments. He goes quiet during hard financial times. He pulls away when you need him the most, right when you can least afford to be alone.

A man who is truly yours behaves differently. During disagreements, he stays in the room instead of walking out and shutting down completely. During hard financial seasons, he works through it with you instead of resenting you. When you are sick, grieving, or struggling, he leans in, rather than away.

Ijeoma saw this clearly the year her mother passed away. Grief made her quiet, tired, and hard to be around some days. Many men might have grown impatient or distant during such a heavy season. Her boyfriend did not. He sat with her silence. He learned when to talk and when to simply hold her hand. He stayed through the hardest year of her life, without complaint, without ultimatums.

There is a quiet strength in a man who chooses you, again and again, without being pushed, pressured, or begged.

Some women spend years asking for commitment, asking for clarity, asking a man to simply decide. That asking itself is telling. A man who is truly yours does not need to be convinced. He makes the choice on his own, and he keeps making it.
